	1852	Phil Holihead was proposed by John Foster as Chair for the meeting and agreed.	
Apologies	1853	Apologies were received from Charles Thackway, Keith Muston and John Lewis.	
Public	1854	15 members of the public attended the meeting.	
Declarations of interest	1855	No declarations were made.	
Opportunity for the public to speak	1856	There were no matters raised by the public.	
Minutes	1857	The minutes of the last meeting having been circulated were taken as read. A councilor raised a question regarding minute 1842. This was debated by councilors who agreed the recording of the minute to stay the same and agreed the minutes.	
Other	1858	The following other items were noted. The closure of the road at Tower Hill; Confirmation of the November meeting being at 6.30pm and followed by the Village Voice presentation of the questionnaire evaluation. It was noted that MP Andrew Murrison had been asked to attend the meeting.	
	1859	The recent fatal accident was discussed and councilors concurred with the letter submitted to the Highways Agency by Fraser Mills concerning the inappropriate white lining on the Black Dog stretch of the A36.	
	1860	It was agreed that CR would investigate and organize the possible planting of trees related to WW1 Commemoration.	CR
Matters Arising Signage on A36	1861	Signage on A36. The Clerk spoke about the recent communication sent to Highways England on this matter and correspondence received. Highways England are awaiting a further proposal from Wiltshire Highways. Councillor Fleur de Rhe Philipe had also been contacted and would keep the Chair up to date.	
Thoulstone	1862	Recent Thoulstone Festival. The complaints of local residents regarding noise and disruption levels in the early hours was noted.	
Housing Consultation	1863	Housing Consultation response. This had been formulated, circulated, agreed and submitted following the last meeting.	

Page 2 Correspondence	1864	Mr. Jefferson had circulated correspondence which indicated that the village sign would be replaced shortly.	
Planning Applications	1865	Land at rear of 52 High Street- Erection of Garden Shed. 17/08328/FUL This would be held over for further information to be acquired on previous planning in relation to conditions. Concerns were raised by the public on storm drainage and surface water issues in Huntenhull lane and the impact of this application. A councilor queried whether trees on the site would be maintained.	
	1866	Land at 26 Southcroft. Single storey dwelling and Garage. 17/08031/FUL The applicants attended the meeting and several neighbours living in the vicinity.	
	1867	Several local residents raised concerns on this application, feeling that the issues raised on a previous application, which was refused, remain the same for this application. Following a lengthy debate, it was agreed that the council would object raising the following concerns:	
	1868	"The council's concerns regarding this application relate to the lack of clarity within this present application in relation to the Parish Councils' and Officers' previous concerns relating to application number 13/06477OUT and whether these have been addressed within this latest application. These specifically relate to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Highways Safety concerns as previously detailed by the Parish Council in application response 13/06477OUT • Drainage of surface water as previously detailed by the Parish Council in application response 13/06477OUT" 	
Flooding in Huntenhull Lane	1869	It was also agreed that the issue of drainage of surface water, and flooding issues within Huntenhull Lane would be raised with the Highways Authority by the Council.	PH
	1870	43 Clearwood View - Division into two dwellings. 17/08335/FUL No objections were raised to this application. Concerns were however raised as to whether the proposed provision for parking is adequate.	
	1871	Speed watch PH discussed the possibility of joining with Dilton Marsh in the sharing of purchased SIDs and a proposal to request funding from the Area Board.	PH

	1872	JF reported on information regarding on line reporting of footpath issues. He would like people to continue to report to him to log the concerns as he can then keep track of progress.	JF
