Apologies	2250	Apologies were received from Charles Thackway.	
Public Opportunity for the public to speak	2251	3 members of the public attended the meeting.	
	2252	There were no items raised from the public.	
	2253	There were no declarations of interest.	
Decs of Interest	2254	The minutes of the last meeting having been circulated were taken as read and approved.	
Matters Arising	2255	Local Boundary Commission Consultation. A councilor discussed the Boundary Review due for Wiltshire and the limited consultation. The scheme had been agreed by committee on 2 nd October. It was due to be heard by council on 16 th October. He commented on how Warminster West had been brought together with Warminster without to bring to required size. Discussion raised concerns of bringing rural and urban together considered undesirable due to the differing needs of such communities and the possible overriding of more attention being given to urban matters as opposed to rural. It was noted that within garrison towns the transitory population mainly do not vote.	
	2256	Following further discussion the action agreed upon was not to respond.	
	2257	Village Plan Update- John Foster reported on the progress of the Village Plan. The reports for each area had been submitted and were being collated by Nigel Brown. It was also noted that a visit from the Bobby Van was being organized to support safety on line and on the telephone and was particularly important for older residents.	
Other Matters of Urgency.	2258	The next meeting would take place on 17 th October 2017.	
	2259	Website. Following discussion around the present village website, its recent difficulties and Parish Council requirements it was agreed that TR, AO and MH would discuss how Parish Council could work with AO in keeping the Village website as a community area with Parish Council taking financial responsibility.

	2261	Wiltshire briefing Note 366 and E mail from WCC re Electoral Review and Briefing note 367 Revised National Planning Policy Framework were brought to the councilors attention.
	2262	<u>Area Board Meeting</u> November 1 st - Chapmanslade Village Hall. The Chair spoke on this meeting and reported that there would be a slot on the agenda for the Parish Council to talk regarding Chapmanslade. He had invited Jacquie Abbott to the Village Coffee morning on 18 th October when he would be able to discuss this with her further.
	2263	PH Reported on his recommendation regarding applying for a grant for a SID, 2 fittings, the cost of maintenance and the possible cost of 50% to be paid by the Parish Council. The issue of joint working with Dilton Marsh was raised and this was no longer being recommended as Dilton Marsh were not ready to go forward.
	2264	PH would like to prepare a bid for consideration by Area Board.
	2265	As traffic and speeding is a high priority for the Parish Council and High on the Village Voice questionnaire, it was unanimously agreed to go forward with the bid.
	2266	PH reported that the Busy Bees pre-school would be joining the speed watch team on the lay by on 10 th October.
	2267	He also reported that the community Policing teams would be in the area in the next two weeks.
	2268	The meeting closed at 8.48 p.m.
