Welcome	2622	The Chairman welcomed the public.	
Public Apologies	2623	7 members of the public attended the meeting.	
	2624	Apologies: Apologies were received and accepted from Keith Muston and John Foster.	
	2625	Apologies had been received from James Croucher from Lochailort who hoped to have more relevant information for the November meeting.	
Decs of Interest	2626	<u>Declarations of Interest.</u> None were given	
Opportunity for the public to speak.	2627	<u>Opportunity for the Public to speak.</u> A member of the public raised an issue regarding the incident at the Village Hall which resulted in hospitalization for two persons and police involvement. The Chair gave assurance that the Village Hall Committee would be reviewing procedures and quoted a statement that had appeared on the Village Face Book regarding this.	
	2628	A member of the council raised concerns regarding the frequency of canisters which are believed to contain laughing gas found on the hall carpark.	
	2629	Further concerns were raised by a member of public regarding the Development of land at Barters farm, the route of construction traffic and whether any further information had been provided by the planning officer. The Chair responded. A councillor also raised concerns regarding the construction traffic needing to access from the A36 and not from the Frome direction. This would be discussed further in the full meeting.	
	2630	A councillor asked if the County Councillor had been asked to attend the meeting. JL reported that as Lochailort would not be attending the meeting and were planning to attend the November meeting she had agreed to attend the November meeting instead.	
Minutes	2631	The public open session was closed and the main meeting of the council commenced. The minutes of the meeting on 19 th September had been circulated prior to the meeting. PJ commented on minute 2603 emphasising that there had been 2 PCSOs and Debbie Robbins

The Clerk apologized for the lateness of the request. JL reported on this with regard to his conversation with Councillor Fleur de Rhe Philippe and the planning officers intentions.</p>
Matters Arising. Road Closure	2633	<p><u>Traffic Issues</u> PJ reported on the road closure at the Dead Maids bridge not going ahead as planned and the intention to move this forward to 15th November. This will be notified 2 weeks prior to closure.</p> <p>FC commented on the sweeper having been through and with all the rain that the ponding/puddling was not observable despite the recent wet weather.</p>
Other matters of Urgency.	2634	<p>Boundary Review publication. It was reported that there was no significant effect within the changes to Chapmanslade.</p>
	2635	<p>PH reported on the CATG meeting and the confusion relating from the request regarding parking on pavement issues raised by a resident. This request was bounced back by CATG. It would require more detailed plans and funding to support. PH will discuss with Martin Rose with a possible site visit and support for a more detailed application.</p>
	2636	<p>It was felt that the pavement parking issue throughout the village should also be referred to a wider forum, in order that a more holistic approach can be taken.</p> <p>PH would act on this.</p>
	2637	<p>PH reported that the replacement solar panel had been fitted and the old one collected, thus negating the invoice received.</p>
	2638	<p>The Clerk reported that Adam Gough, Thoulstone Development, was planning to attend the November meeting to update the council on progress on this development.</p>
	2639	<p>Barters development - Construction traffic use of Cley Hill Gardens - this requires an alternative access and construction traffic should also be entering village from A36 not from the Frome direction. Concerns should be raised formally that these were not in the decisions on planning and raised formally with Manager for planning officer, our county councilor, cabinet member for Spatial Planning, development management and</p>
